QUAINTON SPORTS CLUB -TENNIS SECTION ON-COURT RULES

- 1. Clothing sports clothing must be worn
- 2. Footwear appropriate, clean, non-marking sports shoes must be worn.
- 3. Four players per court is the maximum allowable except for coaching or fun sessions.
- 4. Nets should not be overtightened but set at the correct height (3ft at centre using the measuring stick) using a combination of the winding mechanism and the central vertical band. Modern nets do not have to be wound down after use and can be left at the set height.
- 5. Spectators must be off the court surface.
- 6. Chewing gum must not be deposited on the court surface, nor the nets, net posts or fencing.
- 7. Members are covered by the LTA insurance whilst on the courts.
- 8. Members are allowed to bring the same guest twice.
- 9. Non-members are only allowed on the courts or inside the perimeter fencing with a member of the Quainton Sports Club Tennis Section.
- 10. Coaching sessions for non-members include a charge to cover temporary membership whilst on the courts with the coach.
- 11. The committee reserves the right to invoke clause 2.3 of the constitution if any member or visitor is in contravention of any of these on-court rules.
