- **HS2 Station Road Junction** – Cllr Knox have reviewed the briefing document with Simon Mathews, EKFB, of the new layout of Station road and the new HS2 road. He feedback on speeding and the width of the footpath on this road
- **HS2 School Bus Disruption** – Discussed disruption of school bus disruption since Station road Railway Bridge was closed to heavy vehicles. It was suggested the bus service should resume to Station Road and turn around at Railway Centre
- **Station Road Poor Broadband Speed** - Cllr Whitlock reviewed the funding opportunities to complete Broadband installation in Station Road by utilizing the 151 Station Road, and 62 Station Road developments and S106 money to finish off the Broadband installation
